Jigsaw exercises and group projects are thought to give students more chances to participate in real-world communication and teach them to take greater ownership of their education. According to Thornbury (2004, p. 43), teaching articles is also a cost-

effective method because it is simple to implement by referring students to the grammatical rules found in the teacher-prepared handouts or the grammar portions of a reference book. Using this method lessens the burden of teachers in the teaching and learning process because it is difficult for them to teach grammar articles on their own. According to Thornbury (2004), on page 43, it is "likely to have a more enduring effect on memory than simply reading the rules and doing the exercise".

- 5. Correct Mistakes with Constructive Feedback: When students make errors in article usage, provide constructive feedback to help them learn from their mistakes. Point out specific examples and explain the correct usage in context.
