Roughly 6,3 million students study foreign languages in Uzbekistan which means that vast amounts of printing are required. For just one module of 800 students, an average of 24,000 pages are printed per week, which equates to 0.12 tons of paper, or almost three trees. One ton of paper, roughly 200,000 sheets, requires about 24 trees. Waste paper is often discarded in classrooms, and interactive worksheets tend not to be particularly engaging, especially during online teaching periods. Moreover, interactive questions, audio and video can't be included in printed materials.

So there are a lot of benefits of interactive workbook to students and teachers. Students can use any device in class or at home and students receive immediate feedback after completing each activity and can retry if their answers are wrong.

Teachers can monitor attempts, duration of engagement and quiz scores. It's also helpful to give students general feedback on their performance to encourage them to submit.

As an educator I can say that some teachers use workbooks too much in their classes. As you know that Workbooks are expensive. One of the biggest issues of parents that the pupils cannot reuse it because they have been already written in it. This is particularly annoying when they have a younger sibling coming up behind and they have to purchase for another workbook. It is a trend by publishers to pack a textbook and workbook together meaning that they can only be bought together.

Workbooks typically have only one 'right' answer. It's a pass / fail system. You either got it right or it's wrong. This type of activity can teach children that putting down a wrong answer means failure on their part. It leaves little opportunity for the child to learn about taking risks by guessing or working through a problem in a logical manner.

Workbooks do make life easier for teachers and I do believe that used sparingly they can be useful, however when parents feel that they are too expensive and the

overuse of them can actual limit children, perhaps teachers, authors and publishers could design alternatives.
